Completed typed or printed application and resume.

Minimum of a 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent on a 5.0 scale) cumulative grade point average.

Sophomore, Junior, Senior, or Graduate status for the 2017-2018 academic year and must be in good standing with Alpha Sigma Tau.

Official University Transcripts must be included with the application. They can be sealed and attached to the application or may be mailed directly from the university to the attention of: **2017 Scholarship Applications**

Two (2) Letters of Recommendation:

1. One letter must be from an Alpha Sigma Tau chapter officer or an Alpha Sigma Tau alumna, such as a Chapter Advisory Board member or other volunteer.
2. The 2nd letter must be from a university professor, administrator, organizational advisor, employer, or other credible individual.

Essay – 1 page, typed, double space – Essays will be judged on content, as well as grammar and spelling.
